Scan the image with the Vetscan Imagyst scanner

Using the Vetscan Imagyst scanner, scan the processed cytology sample, then upload it to the ZoetisDx platform.

The pathologist reviews the case and responds

"Once veterinarians upload cases, they're forwarded to us,"
Dr. Martinez says. "And a pathologist will get that case and have results out within two hours¹."

You work with specialists to develop a treatment plan

Once pathologists and other specialists have reviewed and interpreted the cytology samples, they provide a Vetscan Imagyst Cytologic Evaluation Report.
